2022 Theme: "Exploring Human and Ecosystem Response to Wildfire"

The Montana Forest Stewardship Foundation (MFSF) and Montana Society of American Foresters (SAF) are working together this year to host a joint **12th Montana Forest Landowner Conference** and **Montana Society of American Foresters State Meeting**. The joint event will be held on **Friday, April 22** at the **Delta Hotel Helena Colonial in Helena**. This will be the 4th time our two organizations have successfully worked together to co-sponsor our annual conferences.

MFSF is a non-profit organization with the mission of educating and informing landowners, natural resource professionals and the general public about the principles of sustainable forest land management. SAF is a professional society dedicated to sustainable natural resource management through science, education and technology.
